Arthroscopy: You will work on hip models and practice techniques such as fixing labrum with knot less suture anchors.

Pelvic Osteotomy: This involves doing osteotomy on cadaver pelvis, and practicing the concepts learnt on the course.

Advanced Hip: This involves doing pelvis approaches such as Stoppas, Ilioinguinal, iliofemoral, and Kocher-Langenbeck to deal with nonunions in pelvic osteotomies
